

- All Minors (under age 18) are required to be accompanied by a Parent, Guardian, or authorized Chaperone for the duration of the U.S. Junior Camp Contest, notwithstanding whether the junior is on or off _____ premises.
- Minors (under age 18) who choose to camp at _____ (or at _____) shall be accompanied by a Parent, Legal Guardian, or Chaperone at all times.
- Juniors of all ages must clean up after themselves and keep the Youth Camp Kitchen clean (place all garbage in the appropriate garbage/recycling receptacles).
- Camp Fires shall be confined to designated fire rings only (and only where permitted by HHSC).
- No Fireworks!
- Minors and Adults under age 21 shall not possess or consume alcohol.
- No horse-play (especially around gliders).
- Juniors who do not possess a valid Driver License are prohibited from operating a car, truck, or other motor-vehicle anywhere on the premises.
- **Quiet time** starts at **10:00 P.M.**
- There is to be no unpermitted or unnecessary driving on the airfield.
- Drivers shall exercise extreme caution when operating a motor-vehicle around people, aircraft and hangars, and shall obey all posted traffic and speed limit signs.
- All juniors are required to obey the law and any directives from _____, SSA, or _____ contest staff.

Juniors who violate any of the above rules may be expelled from the camp without refund.
